

Behavior for 2018 Wisconsin Wing Military Ball

First and foremost, all CAP members and their guests should remember that this is a *formal CAP Military Ball* and are expected to act, at all times, with courtesy to each other. Any member and/or guest who causes a scene or practices unacceptable behavior will be asked to leave (w/no refund of their ticket cost).

When dancing, all dancers must remain upright—no sexual bending is allowed. Examples are: no hands on knees or on the dance floor, no straddling of each other's legs, grinding, humping, or mashing. Senior Member chaperones deem improper dancing. If found doing any of the above, you will be asked to leave the dance floor.

There will be no jumping on each other and no shoving/pushing. There will be no throwing of food or decorations, creating towers of glasses, or any misuse of decorations.

Each CAP member will make an effort to keep the table and floor area around their table clean. They are responsible for cleaning up their own messes and at the end of the evening will throw away their own garbage before they leave the venue.

Dress Code for 2018 Wisconsin Wing CAP Military Ball

Females will wear a CAP uniform or appropriate civilian attire.

- (1) Appropriate CAP uniforms for **Senior Member**: Mess Dress, Service Dress Uniform or Corporate Dress Uniform; **Cadet**: Semi-Formal or Service Dress Uniform.
- (2) Preferred civilian attire, if worn, is a formal dresses, versus a pant suit.
- (3) Attire should not expose excessive skin or cleavage flowing over dress edges.
- (4) No dress length to extend above the mid-thigh area.
- (5) No dress will have slits extending above mid-thigh.

Males will wear a CAP uniform or appropriate civilian attire,

- (1) Appropriate CAP uniforms for **Senior Member**: Mess Dress, Service Dress Uniform or Corporate Dress Uniform; **Cadet**: Semi-Formal or Service Dress Uniform.
- (2) If worn, civilian attire must be a dress jacket or suit, collared shirt, tie (no silly pictures or sayings or that light up or play music) and appropriate slacks.

No jeans/casual pants/slacks, tee/casual shirts, shorts, etc. are allowed to be worn by members or guests. Members/guests wearing inappropriate clothing will not be allowed into the CAP Military Ball: decision will be made by Senior Member collecting tickets at door.
